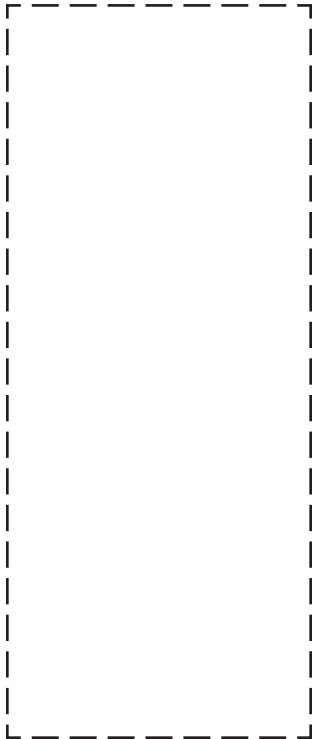

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted until Thursday, February 15, 2018, at 6:00 p.m., after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

ENTRY FEE: \$125.00. A \$.50 recording fee plus \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per Chapter 11, Section 2 of the AKC Rules. Make checks payable to **PAFTA, Inc.**

MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO: Karey Krauter, Test Secretary, 374 Stanford Avenue, Palo Alto, CA 94306.

ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must have been awarded an AKC Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Urban title prior to the close of entries. Dogs holding the title of Tracking Dog Excellent shall not be barred from competition; however, dogs not having a TDX will be given preference by the Test Secretary. Entries are limited to 4 dogs. Entries are limited to AKC recognized pure breed dogs.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and provided that all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations are complied with.

DRAWING: A random drawing of entries received by the closing date and time will be held on Thursday, February 15, 2018, at 6:15 p.m. at Starbucks, 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto, CA 94306, phone 650-320-8125.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

NOTIFICATION: The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

PAFTA REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded within seven (7) days after the test in the following cases: 1) The entrant notifies the Test Secretary prior to the Test that they are withdrawing from the test, and an alternate runs the track, or 2) For an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER: All dogs and handlers must be at the test area by 9:00 a.m. Sunday, February 25, 2018, at which time there will be a drawing to determine running order. Entrants not present at the time of the drawing will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

JUDGING: Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

AWARDS: An award will be offered for each dog passing the test.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

DIRECTIONS: 101 North or South - exit at Cochrane Road. Go East on Cochrane to Malaguerra Avenue (about 1 mile). Left onto Malaguerra Avenue and follow for 0.4 mile. The road bears to the left into the Park parking lot. Parking is free and there is a covered area and rest rooms by the ranger station.

PRACTICING: Practicing on the test sites is not allowed except by ID-carrying members of clubs which have obtained a use permit. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leash at **ALL** times. Your cooperation in adhering to the regulations will be greatly appreciated. Handlers are expected to clean up after their dogs immediately.

NOTE: You are advised to bring tick spray for your dog and yourself as ticks are present in the area.
